

The name of the corporation is:
THE GROVE HOMES ASSOCIATION

II

The corporation is organized pursuant to the General Nonprofit Corporation Law of the State of California.

#### III

- The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed are to provide for the management, maintenance and preservation of the property over which this corporation has jurisdiction, every part thereof, and the improvements thereon for the benefit of the owners thereof, for their pleasure, recreation and other nonprofit purposes, and in furtherance of the foregoing purposes to do any and all things which may be authorized, required or permitted to be done by this corporation under and by virtue of any Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions affecting the property which is subject to the jurisdiction of this corporation, and to do and perform all acts which may be necessary or proper for or incidental to the exercise of any of the express powers of this corporation, for the peace, health, comfort, safety or general welfare of the owners and occupants of property subject to the jurisdiction of this corporation.
- b. In addition and incidental to the specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed, this corporation may carry on any other lawful activity or do anything whatsoever which the corporation may deem proper or convenient or capable of being carried on, in connection with the foregoing or otherwise, or which may be calculated directly or indirectly to promote the interests of the corporation or of the property over which it has jurisdiction; and to have, enjoy and exercise all

of the rights, powers and privileges which are now or which may hereafter be conferred upon nonprofit corporations by the laws of the State of California, including the right to do any and all of the things hereinbefore set forth, as principal and as agent, to the same extent as natural persons might or could do:

- l. acquire (by gift, purchase or otherwise), own, hold, improve, build upon, operate, maintain, convey, sell, lease, transfer, dedicate for public use or otherwise dispose of real or personal property in connection with the affairs of the corporation; and
- 2. borrow money, and mortgage, pledge, deed in trust, or hypothecate any or all of its real or personal property as security for money borrowed or debts incurred.

#### IV

"Property over which this corporation has jurisdiction" or "property subject to the jurisdiction of this corporation," as the foregoing terms are used in these Articles, is and refers to that certain real property, or any part or parts or portion or portions thereof, or interest or estate therein, in the City of Yuba City, County of Sutter, State of California, more particularly hereafter in this Fourth paragraph described, which is or may hereafter be, but only as and when, made subject to a recorded Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions. The real property referred to in this Fourth paragraph is located in the City of Yuba City, County of Sutter, State of California described as:

Lots 1 through 38 and Parcels A & B as shown on that certain Subdivision Map entitled "The Grove - Unit One" (hereinafter "Unit One") filed in the office of the Recorder of County of Sutter, State of California, on November 16, 1978, in Book 12 of Surveys at Page 62 and Lot 17 of Lincrest Village, Unit 2 as recorded in Book 12 of Surveys at Page 56, Sutter County Records, excepting therefrom that portion thereof lying within the boundries of said Unit One.

The principal office for the transaction of the business of this corporation is to be located in the County of Sutter, State of California.

#### VI

The number of Directors of the corporation shall be five (5), which number shall constitute the authorized number of Directors until changed by amendment of these Articles, or by a bylaw adopted by the members of this corporation; and the names and addresses of the persons who are appointed to act as the first Directors of this corporation are as follows:

## VII

These Articles may be amended only by resolution of the Board of Directors and the vote or written consent of members holding a seventy-five percent (75%) majority of the voting power of each class of membership given either before or after adopting a resolution, provided that if there is only one class of membership then the required seventy-five percent (75%) shall include at least

a majority of votes or written consents of the members of that class other than Declarant.

#### VIII.

Every person or entity who is a record owner of a fee or undivided fee interest in any unit ownership which is located in property subject to the jurisdiction of this corporation shall be a member of the corporation. The foregoing is not intended to include persons or entities who hold an interest merely as security for the performance of an obligation. Membership shall be appurtenant to and may not be separated from any unit ownership.

IX

The corporation shall have two (2) classes of voting membership:

Class A. Class A members shall be all owners of unit ownerships with the exception of Declarant and shall be entitled to one vote for each ownership. When more than one person or entity is shown of record to be the owner of a unit ownership, all such persons or entities shall be members. The vote for such unit ownership shall be exercised as the owners thereof among themselves determine, but in no event shall more than one vote be cast with respect to any unit ownership.

Class B. Class B members shall consist of Declarant and shall be entitled to three (3) votes for each unit ownership of which it is the owner in fee. Class B membership shall cease and terminate when the first of the following occurs: when the total votes of Class A members equal or are greater than the total votes of the Class B members, or on the second anniversary of the original issuance of the most recently issued Final Subdivision Public Report issued by the Commissioner of Real Estate for the State of California as to any real property over which this corporation has jurisdiction or on the fourth anniversary of the original issuance of the Final Subdivision Public Report, by said Commissioner of Real Estate for any portion of the property over which this corporation has jurisdiction.

This corporation shall have no capital stock and is not formed for profit. It is a corporation which does not contemplate the distribution of accumulations, gains, profits, or dividends to the members thereof, and is a corporation, no part of the accumulations, gains or profits of which shall be paid or inure to the benefit of any private person, member or individual, and no part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise to influence legislation.

XI

All of the assets and property of this corporation are irrevocably dedicated to the community and civic welfare and interest, and upon the liquidation, dissolution or abandonment of this corporation, none of its assets or property shall inure to the benefit of any private person, but after paying for or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the corporation shall be distributed to any nonprofit unincorporated association consisting of the members of the corporation, if any, which shall succeed to all the rights and obligations of the corporation or any other existing nonprofit organization having the same purposes as this corporation, or to a fund or funds, foundation or foundations, or corporation or corporations organized and operated for the purpose of aiding and developing community and civic welfare and interest within the limits of the County of Sutter, State of California, or within such limits and elsewhere; provided, however, that in the absence of a specific designation or designations by the person or persons or board having authority so to do, then the same shall be distributed to the City of Yuba City, California.

We, the undersigned, for the purpose of forming this corporation, pursuant to the General Nonprofit Corporation
Law of the State of California, do hereby execute these Articles of Incorporation this 15th day of March 1979.
